Special Event in the Central Business District – Jeep Fest, Saturday, August 13, 2022

Main Event and Festival Area

Traffic will be closed and parking is restricted in the Vendor Midway beginning at midnight on Friday, August 12 until mid-day Sunday, August 14, 2022. The following streets are included in this closure:

- Adams – St Clair to Summit
- Jefferson – Huron to Summit
- Madison – Summit to End
- St Clair – Adams to Jefferson
- Summit – Adams to Monroe

Saturday, August 13:

Traffic will be restricted beginning at 8:00 am in the areas bounded by Huron St, Jackson St, Summit St, and Lafayette St, also including Owens Corning Parking Lot and Washington St, East of Summit.

Parade begins at 11:00 am.

After the Parade is over at approximately 12:30, traffic will be allowed on Washington and access to garage on Monroe Street, as well as Summit up to Washington St, within the festival area. Parking on these streets will be restricted.

The following detours will be established:

- NE bound Summit St via Washington St to Erie St to Cherry St
- SW bound Summit St via Jackson St to Michigan St to Washington St

Jeep Parade Route:

Staging on Ottawa Street and in the Owens Corning Parking Lot. Parade will continue up Monroe Street turn North on Huron and continue to Adams Street where the parade will end. The parade participants will be directed up Adams and turn left on Ontario to park at designated locations.

- The following parking garages within the festival area will be open to patrons except during the parade:
 - Superior Street Garage (via Madison to Superior)
 - Seagate Center Garage (via Monroe)
 - Vistula Garage (via Orange)
- **TARTA** will be running regular shuttles from Franklin Park Mall (Royer Rd, near JC Penny) and dropping off at Monroe and Erie.
- Please be considerate and do not park in a restricted area. **Tow trucks will be on duty to remove vehicles illegally parked prior to and throughout the event.**
